Psalm 91:1-16

1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

2 I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.

3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

6 Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

9 Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

Fifteen Conditions of the Blessings of Psalm Ch. 91

1. Dwell in the secret place of the Most High -- under His shadow **(91:1)**.
2. Affirm that God is your refuge **(91:2)**.
3. Affirm that God is your fortress.
4. Affirm that God is your God.
5. Affirm that God is your trust **(91:2,4)**.
6. Have confidence in God as deliverer from every snare and pestilence **(91:3)**.
7. Have confidence in His protection **(91:4)**.
8. Make His truth your shield and buckler.
9. Be not afraid of any terrors, dangers, pestilences, or destructions **(91:5-6)**.





10. Have confidence that the plagues slaying thousands all around you will not come near you (**91:7-8**).
11. Make God your refuge (**91:9**).
12. Make God your habitation.
13. Set your love upon God (**91:14**).
14. Know the name (authority) of God.
15. Call upon God in prayer (**91:15**).

Twenty-three Promises of Psalm 91

1. You shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty (**91:1**).

4. He shall cover you with His feathers (**91:4**).

VERSE TO REMEMBER:





Psalms 34:7

“The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.”

Hebrew 1:14

“Are they not ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?”

In both the Old and New Testaments the root word for angel means **“messenger.”** The Hebrew word *mal’akh* in the Old Testament and the Greek word *angelos* in the New Testament mean simply **“messenger,”** whether human or divine. When these two words refer to messengers from God, as they frequently do, they are translated into English as **“angel.”** Angels are hence the elect (**1 Timothy 5:21**) ambassadors or emissaries of God.

The importance of both the Hebrew *mal’akh* and Greek *angelos* for the study of angels is that both terms describe the function or duty of angels rather than their nature. They tell us what angels do rather than what they are.

The Bible assumes throughout that God is attended by a company or host of heavenly beings who are subordinate to Himself and who share His company and reflect His glory and majesty. But, as mentioned, the Scriptures do not discuss the sociology of these beings in and of themselves. Their existence and fellowship with the Divine is assumed and not infrequently referred to, but when reference is made to them they are presented and discussed only in relation to their function as dutiful servants of God.

In general, angels simply do God’s bidding, whatever that may be. They appear as helpers and protectors to people in need, as proclaimers of news or mediators of revelations from God, and as guides and guardians. Their variety of functions can be summarized in their title of





Hebrews 1:14, “**ministering spirits.**” A primary duty assigned to angels is the protection and guardianship of the faithful. “**The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them,**” assures Psalm 34:7, and God “**Will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways,**” Psalm 91:11.

Jesus was ministered to by angels following His temptation in the wilderness (Matthew 4:11), and in the final book of the Bible, Revelation, He assigns a greater role to angels as helpers, assistants, and servants of God than does any other book in the Bible.

As mediators, angels bridge the gulf between the unseen world of the divine presence and the created world inhabited by humanity, in order to communicate God’s word and will (Hebrews 2:2; Revelation 1:1).

ANGELS AND BELIEVERS

Not only are we given many examples of angels in heaven and earth, we have a number of faith-building scriptures to show the work and ministry of angels to believers.

Angels strengthen believers.

Luke 22:43

Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him.

Angels minister to believers.

Hebrews 1:7, 13-14

7 And of the angels He says: “Who makes His angels spirits And His ministers a flame of fire.”





13 But to which of the angels has He ever said: “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool”?

14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

Angels are agents of God who bear messages from Him.

Luke 1:19

And the angel answered and said to him, “I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of God, and was sent to speak to you and bring you these glad tidings.

Matthew 1:20

Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream, saying,

Matthew 2:13

“Arise, take the young Child and His mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I bring you word; for Herod will seek the young Child to destroy Him.”

Angels minister God’s encouragement and bring peace.

Judges 6:12, 22-23

12 And the angel of the Lord appeared unto him and said unto him, the Lord is with thee, thou mighty man of valor

22 and when Gideon perceived that he was an angel of the Lord, Gideon said, Alas, O Lord God! For because I have seen an angel of the Lord face to face,





23 and the Lord said unto him, Peace be unto you, fear not, you shall not die.

Angels minister God's protection.

Daniel 6:22

My God sent His angel and shut the lions' mouths, so that they have not hurt me, because I was found innocent before Him; and also, O king, I have done no wrong before you."

Angels minister God's guidance.

Acts 8:26

Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza."

In Hebrew 12:22,

Apostle Paul describes the angels that are at the disposal of believers in Christ as **"an innumerable company"**, and they are available to serve us. What a privilege we have in Christ!

I encourage you to begin to practice God's word by sending His angels on specific assignments in your life. Only make sure that your request or command is in line with the word of God.

You can also pray to God to send His angels to you when you need divine intervention. The Bible reveals that God sent angels on missions of mercy to His children. He still does today. He sent an angel to Abraham with promises of blessings (Genesis 22).





He sent angels to the gates of Sodom to rescue righteous Lot from its fiery doom (**Genesis 19**). He sent angels to Elijah, as he was about to perish from weariness and hunger in the desert (**1 Kings 19**). He sent an angel to Elisha with chariots and horses of fire surrounding the little town where he was shut in by his foes (**2 Kings 6:13-18**).

He sent angels to Daniel, while seeking divine wisdom in the court of the heathen king and when he was abandoned to be the lion's prey (**Daniel 6**). He sent an angel to rescue Peter, who was doomed in Herod's dungeon (**Acts 12**). He sent angels of deliverance to the prisoners at Philippi (**Acts 16**). He sent an angel to Paul and his companions in the night of tempest on the sea (**Acts 27**).

He sent an angel to open the mind of Cornelius to receive the gospel (**Acts 10**). He sent an angel to dispatch Peter with the message of salvation to the Gentile stranger (**Acts 10**). All these points to the truth that in all ages, these holy angels have ministered to God's people. My prayer is that they will minister mercy, grace, help, healing, deliverance, blessings, peace, joy, progress and all-round fulfillment to you today, in the name of Jesus.

Beloved, a closed mouth is a closed destiny. Cry unto God and tell Him to send His angels on a mission of mercy into that particular area of your life or that situation that has been a huge burden to you all these whiles. Make your requests in the holy and wonder-working name of Jesus. Your help is here!

How can you get angels to go on assignment for you or minister for you the inheritor of salvation?

First, you must be a born-again child of God to enjoy this special privilege.

Second, you must live a life of holiness and purity, within and without.





Third, you must be a lover of God's word and live by it and speak it always. Angels hearken unto God's word!

Fourth, you must live in complete, prompt and unquestioning obedience to God.

Fifth, you must be a prayer warrior and a lover of praise and worship.

ANGELIC PRAYER POINTS:

MORNING

1. Father, I need angelic intervention and help. Send Your angels to me today, in the name of Jesus.
2. Angels of mercy, my life is available, visit and bless me now, in the name of Jesus.
3. Angels of war, arise and fight my battle, in the name of Jesus.

5. Father, send Your angel to roll away every stone assigned to block me, in the name of Jesus.
6. Father, send Your angel to remove any filthy garment from me and replace it with the garment of Your glory, in the name of Jesus.

EVENING

1. Father, send Your angel to deliver me from captivity and trouble today, in the name of Jesus.
2. Father, let Your angels dispatch and deliver to me the blessings that money can buy and the blessings that money cannot buy, in the name of Jesus.





3. Angels of the Living God, recover my virtues and glory from demonic hands, in the name of Jesus.
4. Father, give me the strength, speed and wisdom of an angel, in the name of Jesus.
5. Angels of the Living God, be my guards, day and night, in the name of Jesus.
6. Angels of good news, deliver glad tidings of great joy to me today, in the name of Jesus.
7. Any evil thing assigned to push my angels of blessing away from me, scatter now, in the name of Jesus.
8. Angels of God, arise, bring God's word of favour and blessings to fulfilment in my life today, in the name of Jesus.
